

**Normal format for degree project (x-jobb) seminar at Water Resources Engineering (tvrl). / 1 hour in total.**

The supervisor acts as chairperson. The examiner shall normally be present. The respondent (author) gets maximum 30 minutes for presenting the work. Then the opponent has maximum 15 minutes for opposition. Finally anybody may ask questions.

**About opposition at degree project (x-jobb) seminars.**

The objective of the opposition is to initiate an interesting discussion about the work done by the respondent. It is **not** the duty of the opponent to examine the report and/or the student, in the formal sense – that is done by the examiner/professor.

The opponent should focus on the main issues during the seminar. Details should be covered before or after the seminar in direct contact with the respondent. Details might be interesting for the seminar if they are important for the big picture.
